Reporting to the Director of Engagement and working collaboratively with the Digital Communications Officer, this position will serve as the English content coordinator and curator for ICEERS' social media channels, newsletter, and website.

JOB DESCRIPTION

- Works with the Director of Engagement and Digital Content Officer to develop and implement content strategies for ICEERS online communications platforms.
- Creates and posts daily content that engages and expands our audiences and drives conversations and support around ICEERS research, advocacy campaigns, programs, events, and other priorities.
- Creates and implements dissemination plans for key advocacy campaigns, publications, and initiatives and engages supporters and coalition members in support of these priorities.
- Collaborates with the Digital Content Officer to review analytics data, research current trends, and to proposes and executes strategies to engage ICEERS priority audiences through online channels.
- Oversees planning, writing, translating of English blog and video content for the ICEERS website and coordinates translation into Spanish.
- Reviews and revises English content and translations, supporting Spanish speaking team members to create high -level English content.
- Collaborates with the Digital Content Officer to maintain and evolve the ICEERS website.
- Supports the development and implementation of promotion plans for events and large conferences.
- Works with appropriate ICEERS departments to increase the frequency of dissemination of research, educational material, policy analysis and program updates to appropriate segments of our email lists and through social media.
- Assists ICEERS staff spokespeople and program representatives in the use of online communications channels in support of organizational priorities.
